



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Getting the right item to the right customer

If the item cannot be identified how can it be picked / sent.

Correct identification may have been applied by the supplier.

If not part of the "goods in" procedure is to label / identify each item or

via a WMS system ensure that items are correctly loaded in storage areas.

Bar coding and 2D coding of items and locations speeds up processes and reduces errors.

QVC – scan item, integrate with order processing, print label, route the parcel





WMS implementations must be considered holistically not just as a quick fix to underlying problems




