- 43.9% expect to increase headcount over the next 6 mths Barclays UK Logistics Confidence Index




The UK Logistics Confidence Index H2 2016 Slight increase in confidence despite headwinds



The impact on logistics

- 3 times as much warehousing space is required for online fulfilment
- 20m sq ft of space built in 2016
- 9m sq ft built in preceding 5 years
- 58% taken by the retail sector
